Remarks :	A population of the sub-endemic species - <i>Iris pseudopumila</i> has been located at a garigue in Dingli, not very far from the Cliffs. The site is, partially sheltered by <i>Opuntia-ficus-carica</i> , not easily accessible to the public, and little competing vegetation. The population of numerous plants close to each other covered an area of 4m in diameter. In Winter, the colour of the flowers could be determined. After communicating with Edwin Lanfranco and Darrin Stevens, it came out that <i>I. pseudopumila</i> has never been recorded from Dingli cliffs.



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
